Somerset, NJ -- The Somerset County Democratic Committee Black Caucus (SCDCBC) is pleased to announce that applications are currently being accepted for the Somerset County Future (Political) Leaders Scholarship. Applications are now being accepted through December 18, 2020.

The Somerset County Future (Political) Leaders Scholarship recognizes continuing undergraduate college students of African descent who reside in Somerset County and have “demonstrated a commitment to community activism and engagement towards their community’s socio-economic health and well-being in New Jersey”.

Awards

Two undergraduate scholarship awards are available in the amount between \$500.00 to \$1000.00 each for a single year. Awards are for one year only; however, recipients may re-apply for a second year. All scholarship awards will be announced no later than February 5, 2021 and paid directly to the recipients at the SCDCBC Scholarship Luncheon on March 6, 2021.

Criteria

The scholarship is restricted to continuing undergraduate students attending a 4-year accredited college or university as a sophomore or junior.

Additionally, applicants must: (1) reside in Somerset County (2) have a demonstrated interest in the political arena (3) be a US citizen of Black African descent (4) have completed at least one (1) year of college credits by the time the award is received.
