Women in prison have long suffered because prisons and jails have often been designed by men for men. In addition, women's healthcare—as applies to medical, behavioral, including mental health and addiction, and particularly OB/GYN—has often been ignored at best or at worst been a source of maltreatment and malfeasance.

Women who have survived trauma after trauma, are then retraumatized in state prison. 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WHAT IS THE WOMEN'S PROJECT?

HEALTHCARE

Healthcare for women in prison has traditionally underserved female inmates—who far too often were victims of trauma in their upbringing—in their daily lives, and particularly in prison. Women in prison historically are victims of domestic violence, sexual abuse, and addiction. The objective of The Women's Project is to provide excellence in coordinated and integrated medical and behavioral healthcare, including mental health and addiction treatment. Medical challenges include access to OBGYN services, diabetes, hepatitis B/C, and HIV/AIDS. Mental health concerns include depression, anxiety—along with their linkage to reproductive cycles—and the legacy of trauma. Addiction treatment in response to OUD (opiate use disorder) requires

detoxification, residential treatment, intensive IOP (intensive outpatient), and Medication Assisted Treatment.

EMPLOYMENT & TRAINING

Employment & training for women returning from state prison and county jails is typically a difficult challenge. State licensing boards routinely ban women with criminal convictions from consideration for regulated industries, as do many national corporations. To overcome the strong bias against employing court-involved and formerly incarcerated women, The Women's Project is committed to providing for financial literacy in partnership with TD Bank, Investors Bank, and M&T Bank, entrepreneurial training through Operation Hope, and employment opportunities through the The New Jersey Business & Industry Association.

NJRC'S MISSION

The NJRC is a nonprofit organization that works with individuals returning from prison, jail, and/or probation and aims to provide them with job training and employment, addiction treatment, structured sober housing, linkage to legal services and healthcare, Motor Vehicle Commission identification, and spiritual mentoring.

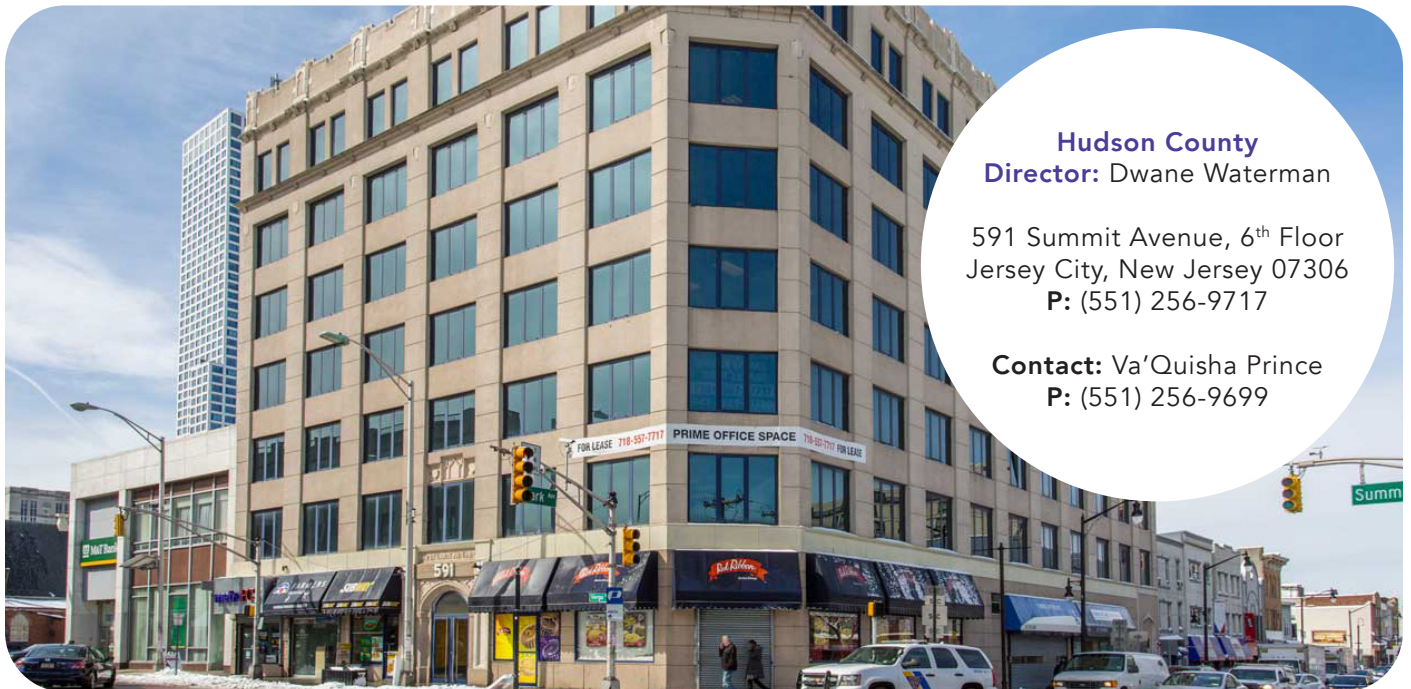

More than half of 908 women surveyed at Edna Mahan reported being the victim of two types of abuse prior to incarceration—emotional, physical, and/or sexual—with nearly a third reporting having been the victim of all three.¹³ Partly as a result of such trauma, many of these women also suffer from mental health and substance use disorders, with roughly half of all women in state prison systems reporting having been using a substance at the time of their offense,¹⁴ and many reporting an inability to access addiction treatment and recovery services prior to incarceration.¹⁵

A growing body of research has brought the deep and lasting effects of trauma to light. In particular, a number of experts have identified how potentially traumatic experiences—such as

being the victim of or bearing witness to abuse, violence, and instability—can generate a kind of toxic stress that increases the risk of several health conditions.¹⁶ When such traumatic experiences occur during childhood, they are often referred to as adverse childhood events (ACEs) and have been shown to adversely affect brain development.¹⁷ Such results in ACEs having the ability to hamper attention, decision-making, learning, and responses to stress.¹⁸

The quality and nature of treatment behind the wall has implications for treatment post-release. Among women incarcerated at Edna Mahan who wish to participate in a substance abuse treatment program, between 31 and 45 percent do not have access.¹⁹

40 percent of women with substance use disorders receiving treatment in state prisons nationally, only one-quarter are still receiving treatment services eight to ten months after their release.²⁰

When reentering persons do receive mental and physical healthcare treatment post-release, because of a lack of health insurance, which is an endemic feature of reentry, more than one-third of those reentering will do so through emergency departments, and one-fifth through hospitalizations.²¹

Developing stronger protocols for identifying, diagnosing, and treating mental health and substance use disorders, while ensuring that the protocols utilized focus heavily on the sex-specific differences among incarcerated populations, is necessary to improve overall employment and reentry outcomes.²²

For formerly incarcerated women, education and access to appropriate mental health treatment are likely the most significant barriers to successfully obtaining long-term employment and achieving desirable reentry outcomes.²³ The provision of behavioral health services that treat both underlying substance use and mental health disorders also contribute to an increased likelihood of success in securing full-time employment.²⁴
